| <p>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) £1,940.00</p> <p>This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.</p> <p>Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements £ 745.00</p> <p>Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care £ 275.00</p> <p>Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. £ 170.00</p> <p>The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises</p> <p>Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from oak/elm wood-effect chipboard £ 325.00</p> <p>Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends £ 60.00</p> <p>by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)</p> <p>At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person £ 365.00</p> <p>direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle</p> |
| <p>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</p> <p>This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</p> <p>Burial (funeral director's charges only)¹ £1,150.00</p> <p>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)² £1,131.00</p> |
| <p>FEES YOU MUST PAY</p> <p>For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee</p> <p>In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: £715 - £1372.50</p> <p>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</p> <p>For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee²</p> <p>In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: £946 - £1220</p> |

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
